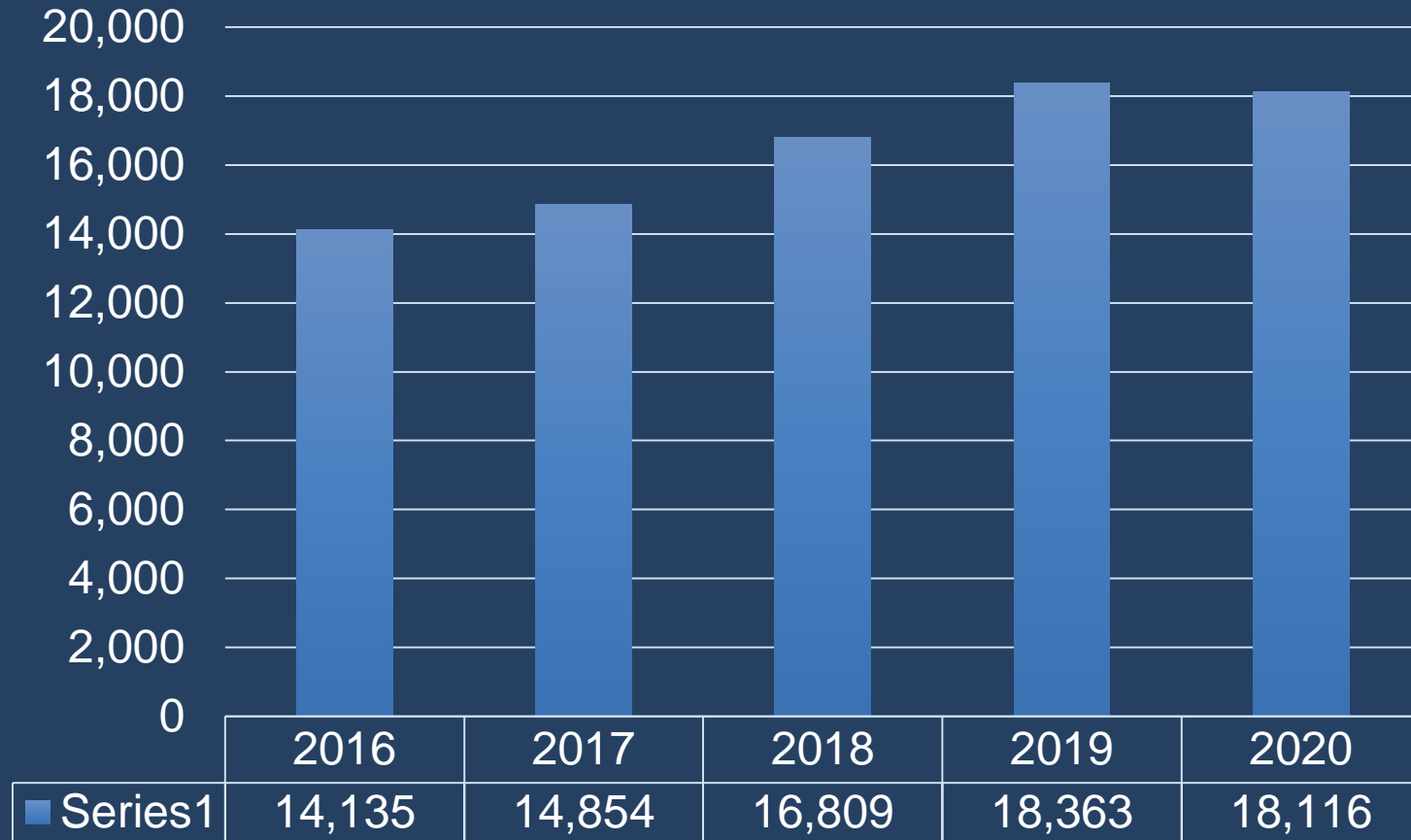

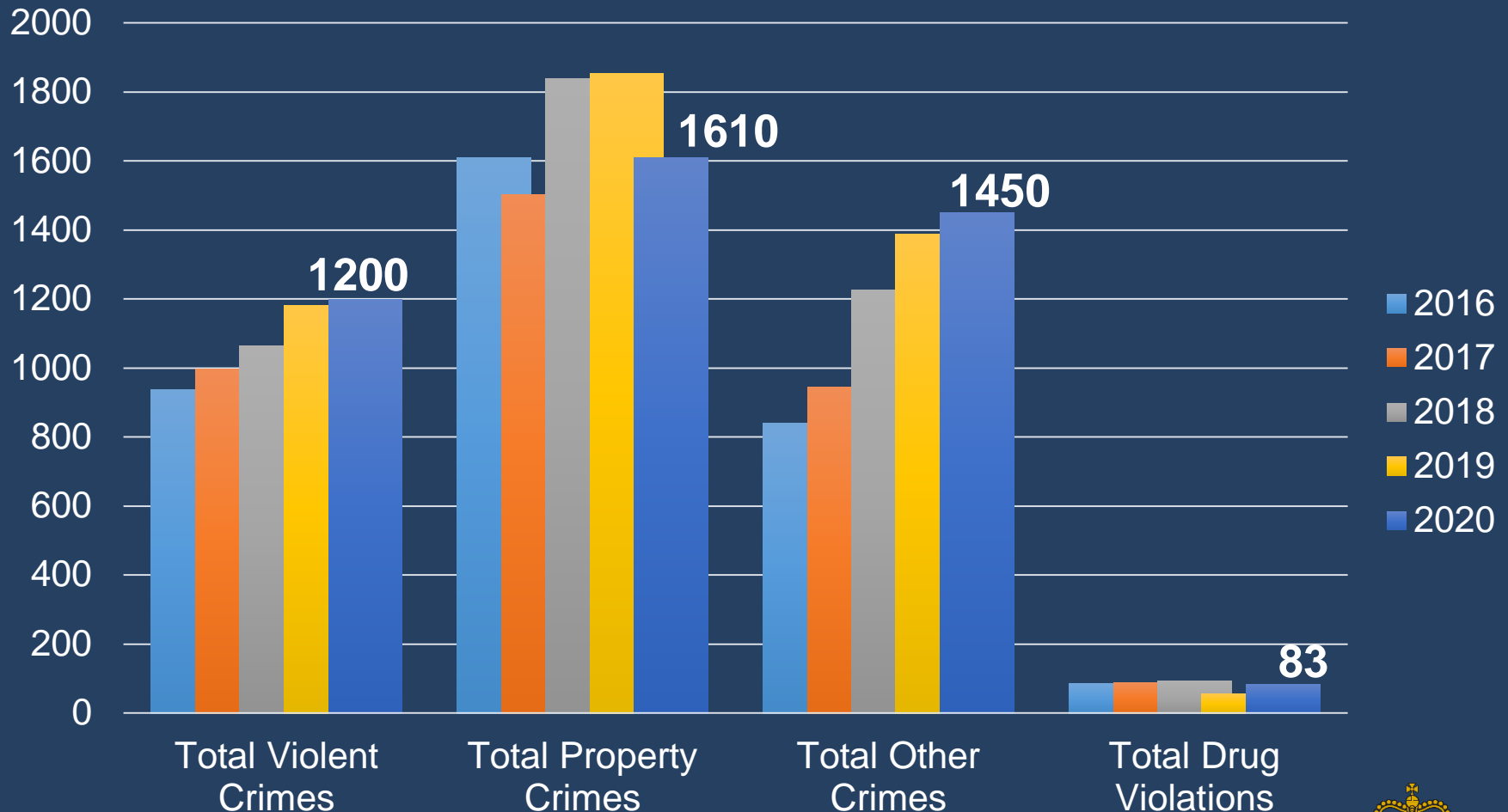
CALLS FOR SERVICE



- 23% increase in calls for service since 2016
 - Anticipated to increase again in 2021



5-YEAR TREND



*Violent Crimes and Other Crimes continue to be trending upwards.
Property crime decrease in 2020 can be attributed to less shoplifting and associated offences due to the closure of businesses during the pandemic*

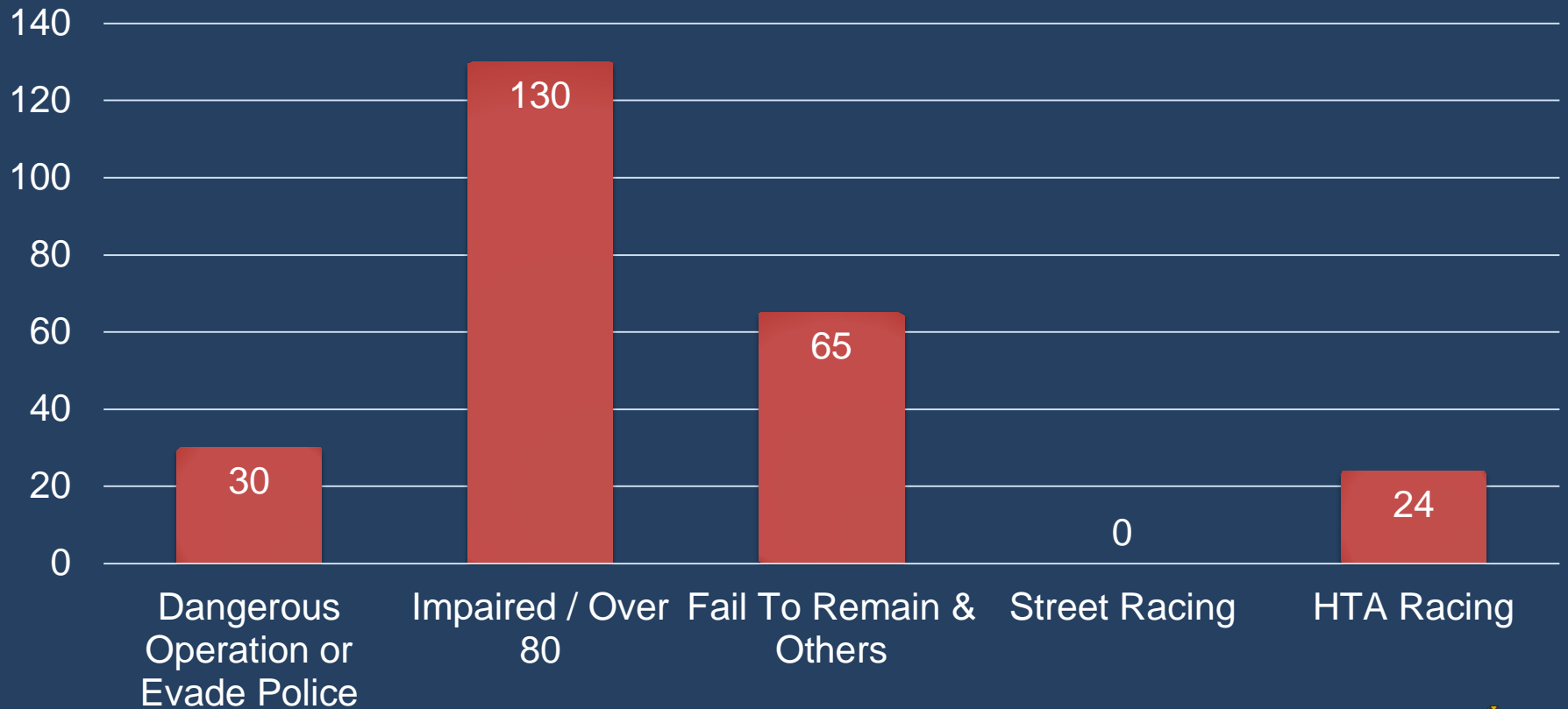
368 domestic-related charges laid

861 domestic calls where no offence is alleged

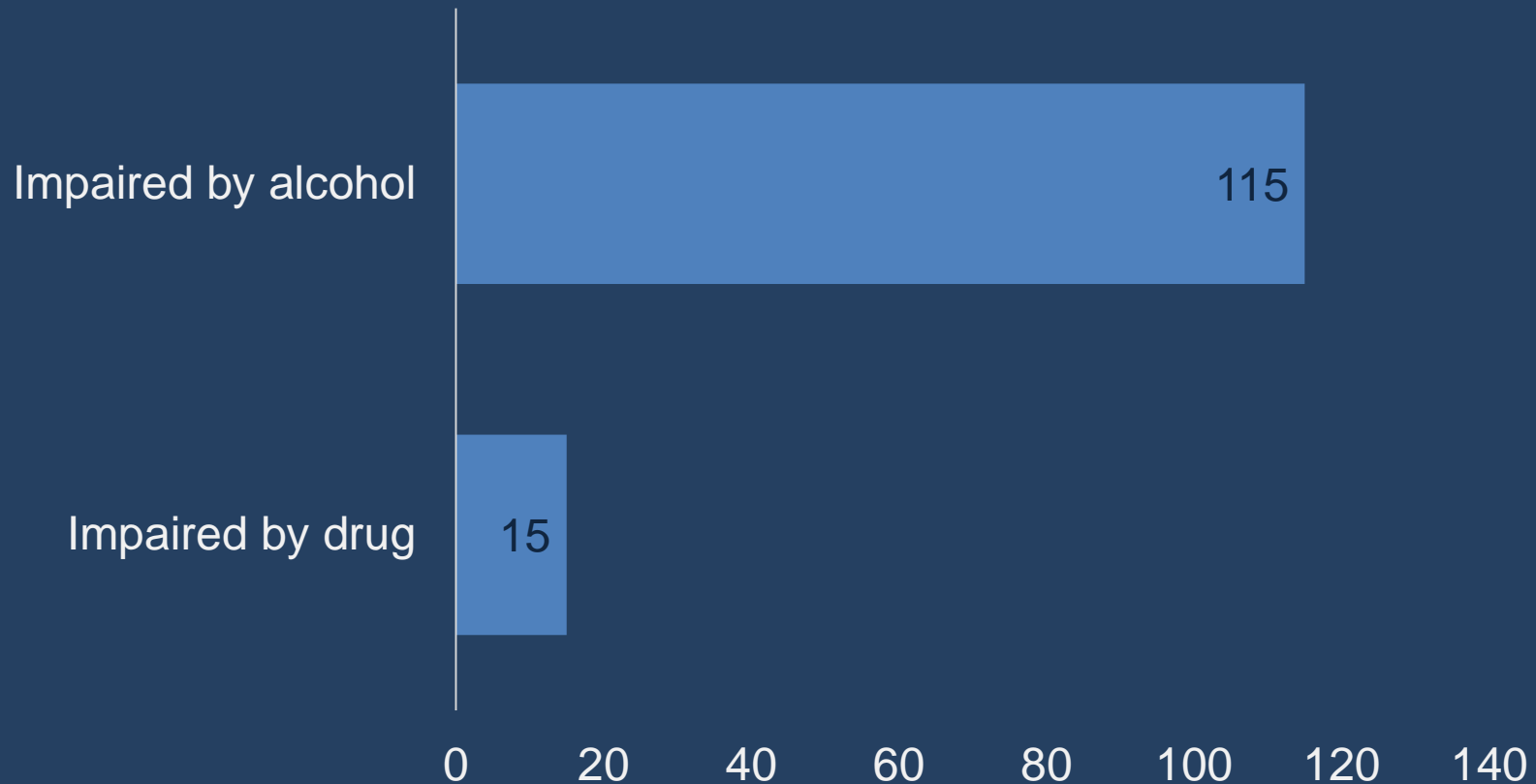
31% of domestic-related charges were for assault



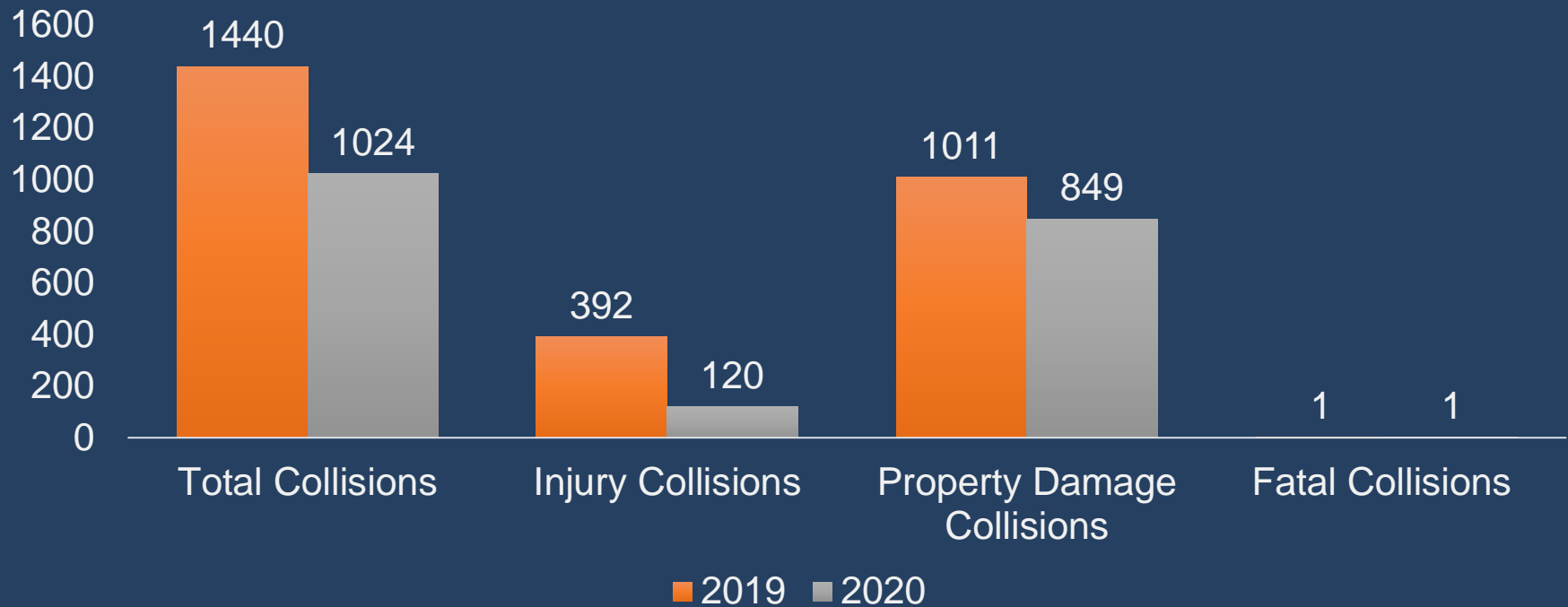
2020 CRIMINAL DRIVING CHARGES

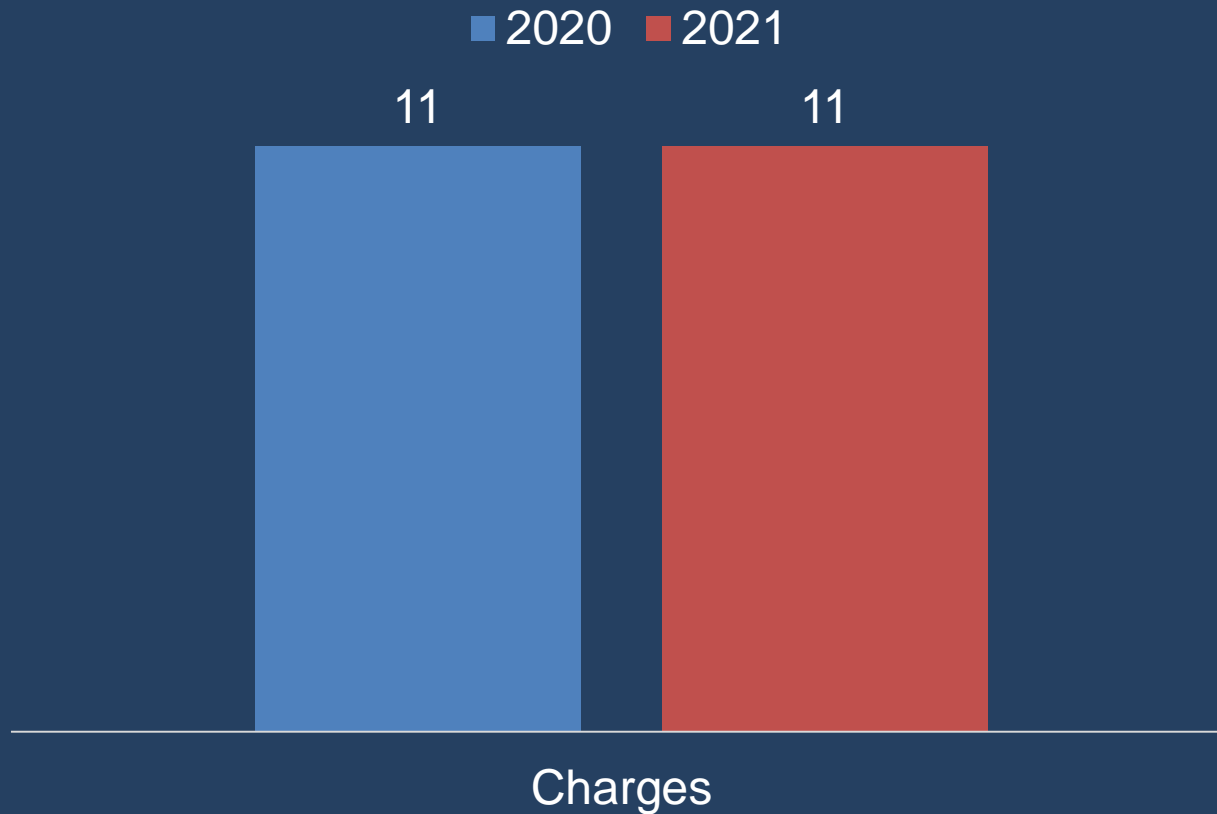
